Minutes of Meeting: Minutes of the meeting held on 4th December 2012 were agreed as correct after the following correction:

Mr Andrew Seddon will be taking over the editing of the Newsletter and not the publishing. These were then signed by the Chairman.

Matters Arising: Mr R Fisher attended the Airport Meeting and reported on the Aviation Business Park which is planned. The initial access will be off the roundabout on the A140 until the NDR is built.

The base for the monument at the Church, Mr S Catterall reported that he would hopefully be able to do the work within the next couple of weeks, weather permitting.

Special Dispensation: This was proposed by the Chairman for this meeting only for the purpose of setting the precept. This was agreed by all Councillors.

County Councillor: Budgeting still continuing by Norfolk County Council for the new year starting in April.

Norfolk Right of Way issues have been changed and toughened up.

Community Construction Fund, still have funding available.

Health and Well-being Council, responsibility for local health is moving into joint partnership with the NHS and County Council.

Declaration of Interest: Mr K Robertson declared an interest with regard to the planning application No. 20121598.

New Homes Bonus: No update at present.

The meeting was suspended for Mr B Plumstead to give an update on the Emergency Plan. Up to date information on the Emergency Plan was distributed to all Councillors and Clerk by Mr Plumstead.

Broadland District Council may issue a set of 2 way radio's free of charge.

Possibility of another exercise meeting to be held at the Village Hall. Date to be arranged.

Mr Plumstead to look into arranging a First Aid Course by the Red Cross.

The meeting was re-opened.

Broadland Home Watch: No further information at present, to go on next Agenda.

Street Furniture Consent: This is for a bench to be placed in memory of Christine Broughton.

The consent form has been signed by Norfolk County Council so the work can now go ahead. To go on next Agenda.

Precept: An accounts summary had been circulated to all Councillors by the Clerk. All Councillors agreed to keep the precept the same as last year £8250.00.

Highways: Clerk to contact Highways again with regard to the staggered junction sign on the Buxton Road at the junctions of Fettenham Lane and Church Road. Also the 20MPH sign which still has not been collected. This is now on Church Road, next to a large pothole on the opposite side of the road to Hall Barn.

Clerk to send a thank you letter to highways with regard to the gritting of the roads in Frettenham. The gritting lorry came through the village on 3 occasions during the bad weather.
